BIBLIO addresses the skills gap in the library sector caused by the digital transformation that is changing the role of libraries and library professionals. BIBLIO facilitates the acquisition of digital and transversal skills. The training targets library professionals and unemployed people in the library sector. It enables them to offer innovative services for users.

Project results:

- Full report on library professional needs
- The BIBLIO VET Curricula (EQF5)
 - · Community Engagement and Communication Officer (CECO)
 - · Digital Transformation Facilitator (DIGY)
- Training programme tested in 4 piloting countries:
 - MOOC of 10 weeks (1st edition completed in Oct-Nov 2021)
 - Specialization courses on the two BIBLIO profiles including:
 - 240 hours of Blended training;
 - 20 hours of Face to Face sessions;
 - 160 hours of Digital/Virtual Classes and self-study
 - 40 hours of Project-based/collaborative learning
 - 25 hours of Assessment
 - 160 of work-based learning experiences (traineeships or job-shadowing)

Community engagement and communication officer (CECO)

The community engagement and communication officer reaches out to underserved communities to identify, pilot, and establish both building and non-building based library services that boost engagement and address barriers to library use, literacy, and digital inclusion.

Digital transformation facilitator (DIGY)

The digital transformation facilitator supports their colleagues and the library's activities in the transition to the digital era. They support digitisation activities and the use of new digital tools within the library.
